Pioneer Hall of Fame: Dr. Stephen N. Doran, class of 1975



The University High School Alumni Association honors Dr. Stephen N. Doran, class of 1975, as a 2012 inductee to the Pioneer Hall of Fame for his achievements and contributions to his profession and to the community.

Since starting his own practice in 1990, Doran has served the Bloomington-Normal community as an oral surgeon. In 2011, he received the Illinois State Dental Society's President's Award for his special contribution to the dental profession. For the past decade, Doran has coordinated and organized a free extraction clinic in Bloomington. Twice each year, he has helped assemble a team of local dentists to perform free extractions for approximately 150 patients at Saturday morning clinics. Largely for those efforts, the McLean County Dental Society has honored him twice with The President's Award.

Doran has served on the board of directors of the John M. Scott Health Resources Center with the City of Bloomington, which has a mission of providing health education, information, and referral services for those in need. In 2010, he served as the lead surgeon in the oral surgery department of the Illinois State Dental Society's inaugural Illinois Mission of Mercy.

Following U-High, Doran graduated from Illinois Wesleyan University. He is a graduate of the Southern Illinois University School of Dental Medicine, and completed the Cook County Hospital Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residency Program. He has remained involved with U-High as a member of the Citizens Advisory Committee. Doran's wife, Joy '75, and his three daughters, Molly '03, Flynn '05, and Anna '08 are all graduates of Metcalf and U-High.
