Call to order/Roll call

Meeting called to order by Jennifer McDade at 6:30 on January 10, 2024.

Officer Reports

President

Jennifer McDade

- Quick update on IRS filing for tax exempt status (see full update in treasurer report, Shannon)
- Request for support of Shriner's ad for U High player/s. Joe Hunt came to the meeting to
 discuss his participation in this summer's IL Allstar Shriner game on June 15 at IWU. Funds
 raised through this game benefit the Shriner's Hospital for Children. Asking for support for
 IL Allstar Shriner game. Joe left a brochure with suggested donation amounts.
- Next steps on After Prom fundraising (Joan/Terry)
 As a summary of the background on the fundraising, typically U-High Boosters runs two fundraisers: Gold Rush and Cash Bash. Funds are used for grants and After Prom.
 Historically, Cash Bash raises a lot of money but also costs a lot of money and takes many volunteer hours. To alleviate some of the concerns from previous years, it was suggested to look at alternate methods to raise funds. Joan presented the option to donate online rather than by hosting a Cash Bash event which costs \$75/ticket. Feedback to the online option after discussion in October was mixed but generally favorable of exploring another option.
 - SnapRaise is an online platform that runs fundraisers with a 80/20 split. They manage
 everything online with a user-friendly interface. They also make it easy to track giving
 and cover credit card fees. Donors can choose the amount to donate over 28 days. Has
 seen success in boys soccer and volleyball. For reference, Cash Bash made \$16k and
 spent \$6k in 2023.
 - Target Amount? How much does it cost to run AfterProm? \$5k is minimum we would need, \$10k would be great, \$15k would be amazing. If we happened to raise money above and beyond, there is now a plan in place for what to do if there is extra money which is to work with Administration to spend at the school.
 - Hatch is an alternate donation site through ISU. Could we do a Boosters account that is
 not through the Foundation. Hatch was what was used for Giving Tuesday. Meeting with
 ISU on Friday (determined that the funds would need to go through the ISU
 Foundation.)

 Plan B if enough isn't raised through this options is a potential other event (different venue, something different/creative). Ideas: direct mailing,
 Three outlets for notifying others of Boosters: Main Calendar, Andrea's Sunday email, Boosters subpage. The Boosters page was not updated. Tim will work with Steve Corrigan to ensure the page is updated. After Prom background checks. Sometimes the need to get a background check might deter someone from volunteering at events, but don't let this deter you, the background check is simple. Band trip chaperoning. Wonderful experience and worked with great kids. If presented with chance to chaperone, take it.
The minutes from November will be posted soon along with the January meeting minutes. We will approve both at the February meeting.
 See treasurer report attached at the end of this document. December was relatively slow with incoming funds for spirit wear sales and a deposit of collections for Faculty Appreciation. Small expenses for Gold Rush and Credit Card fees. See attached report. IRS Tax Exemption status was fully approved in December. This was setting up U-High Boosters as a full non-profit. We have a EIN and after this week will be fully approved. We could also apply for state sales tax exemption. If our income stays \$50,000/year to stay under simple tax filings. Next step will be establishing PayPal or other methods for tax exempt organizations to receive funds electronically or via CC. This will need to replace our current system used to accept credit card payments.
