## AFFORDABILITY AND ACCESS

- Like all public schools, U-High is tuition-FREE
  - It has fees, just like Unit 5 and District 87
- Students eligible for free/reduced lunch receive:
  - fee waivers
  - free textbooks

- All U-High students get:
  - a laptop
  - access to Office 365 & Google Workspace
  - access to all Illinois State
     University library
     resources
    - Can study at Milner

# AFFORDABILITY AND ACCESS

Q: Does U-High provide busing to and from school?

**A**: No, but other forms of transit are available. U-High does provide transportation to and from extracurricular activities.

ALL students have access to ride Connect Transit for FREE via their school-issued, Redbird ID card




## TRANSIT EXAMPLE:

A student lives near the Hilltop mobile homes in S. Bloomington

- 1. Book a ride via the "Connect Transit App" to the Walmart on the west side of Bloomington (closest bus stop to U-High that is in the Connect Flex service area) a. This should take about 8-12 minutes
- 2. Get on the Lime Route bus (runs every 30 minutes), headed to Uptown Normal
- 3. Get off at Cardinal Court
  a. This should take about 12 minutes
- 4. Walk one block to U-High a. This should take about 2-3 minutes





### TRANSIT EXAMPLE:

#### Transit time from Walmart to U-High via the Lime Route:
