

UNIVERSITY HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIPS APPLICATION

There are a number of scholarships available for U-High seniors that require an application submission and review. Before filling out the application below, please read all of the requirements that must be met to be considered an eligible candidate. If you have any questions, please email Dr. Fitz (rjfitzg@ilstu.edu) prior to the submission deadline. All applications are due Monday, April 24 by 3:00pm. They should be submitted directly to the Counseling Center.

Dr. and Mrs. Harry D. Lovelass U-High to ISU Scholarship

1. Two seniors who have been accepted and enrolled to attend Illinois State University in the fall semester following graduation from University High School.
2. Whenever possible, one of the two scholarships is to be awarded to a student enrolling in the College of Education and the other to a student enrolled in any college at Illinois State University.
3. Academic achievement at University High School of at least a 3.2 grade point average.
4. Demonstrated evidence of leadership and service while a student at University High School, such as involvement in athletics, band, cheerleading, orchestra, drama, debate, team manager as well as assuming leadership/participation as a Senate member, class officer, yearbook or newspaper staff member, student tutor, homecoming or prom committees, community service, etc.

John Ryan Hamilton-Hamada Family Scholarship

1. Student should be involved in band and enjoy the rigors of math and science classes.
2. Student must be a senior who will enroll in a college or university in the fall semester following graduating from U-High.
3. Student should demonstrate a commitment to challenging themselves, making a difference in the lives of others and being interested in exploring differing ideas.

CJ Hamilton-Hamada Family Scholarship

1. Student should be involved in track and field and enjoy the challenge and rigor of English and Literature classes.
2. Student must be a graduating senior who will enroll in a college or university in the fall semester following graduation from University High.
3. Student must demonstrate courage, perseverance and commitment to overcome challenging circumstances.

Bernerd I. Lowery Endowed Scholarship

1. A senior who has been accepted and enrolled to attend Illinois State University in the fall semester following graduation from University High School.
2. Academic achievement at University High School of at least a 3.2 grade point average.
3. Demonstrated financial need.
4. Demonstrated evidence of leadership and service while a student at University High School, such as involvement in athletics, band, cheerleading, orchestra, drama, debate, team manager as well as assuming leadership/participation as a Senate member, class officer, yearbook or newspaper staff member, student tutor, homecoming or prom committees, community service, etc.
5. Submission of two references from University High School faculty. (Please attach both letters to this application or have teachers turn them in directly to the Counseling Department.)

Clyde B. Coombs Endowed Scholarship

1. A senior University High School student who is a U.S. citizen.
2. Student has been accepted and enrolled to attend a community college or university in the Central Illinois area in the fall semester following graduation from University High School.
3. Academic achievement at University High School of at least a 3.0 grade point average.
4. Demonstrated evidence of leadership and service while a student at University High School, such as involvement in athletics, band, cheerleading, orchestra, drama, debate, team manager as well as assuming leadership/participation as a Senate member, class officer, yearbook or newspaper staff member, student tutor, homecoming or prom committees, community service, etc.

Peter Parmantie Educational Endowed Scholarship

1. A senior at University High School who is planning to seek a degree in Education or a related field.
2. Recognized as an independent thinker.
3. Demonstrates clear communication skills and a desire to learn.

Lexie and Steven Greeneberg Scholarship

1. A senior at University High School who will enroll in a college or university in the fall semester following graduation from U-High.
2. Demonstrates growth, service and leadership in creative programs (for at least 4 semesters at U-High), including music, visual arts, film, dance, creative writing or other fine arts.
3. Demonstrates financial need.
4. Must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.2 out of 4.0

Marilyn and Donald Turner Endowed Scholarship

1. A senior in good standing at University High School.
2. Academic achievement at University High School of at least a 3.2 grade point average or being ranked in the top 20% of their class.
3. Plans to major in either Education or Architecture at an institution of higher education.
4. Demonstrated involvement in high school and/or community activities.

Illinois Soldiers' and Sailors' Children's School (ISSCS) Memorial Endowed Scholarship

1. A graduating senior who will enroll in a college or university in the fall semester following graduation from University High School.
2. Student must be raised in the home of a single parent or in foster care.
3. Preference will be given to students with demonstrated financial need.

Aubertine Family Scholarship for University High School

1. A graduating senior who will enroll in a college or university in the fall semester following graduation from University High School.
2. Preference will be given to students majoring in Education, English or Literature.
3. Demonstrated financial need.

Crossroads Scholarship

1. A graduating senior at University High School.
2. Demonstrated financial need.
3. A grade point average in the middle to upper middle quadrant of their class. Preference will be given to students demonstrating academic improvement between their freshman and senior years.
4. Exhibits a positive school spirit and participates in extra co-curricular activities.
5. Acceptance to an accredited junior/community college or four-year college or university.

Dennis Kelly Scholarship

1. A graduating senior at University High School.
2. Intending to major in education or a related discipline.

Derek Nanni University High School Memorial Scholarship

1. Enrolled in a college or university in the fall semester following graduation
2. Cumulative GPA of a minimum of 3.0
3. Exhibits a positive school spirit, displays selflessness
4. An active participant in school sports and extracurricular activities
5. Preference given to students that participate in track, cross country, swim

Helping Hand Scholarship

1. Enrolled as a graduating senior and in good standing at University High School
2. A 1st or 2nd generation U.S. Citizen or permanent resident student intending to pursue higher education
3. Accepted and/or enrolled in a 4-year college or university, a 2-year college, or a vocational/trade school upon graduation
