Dual Enrollment at Illinois State – Spring 2023

All interested students must complete the following steps by the deadlines listed; failure to meet these deadlines will end your participation in this program for the upcoming semester.

Course availability and selection is **not guaranteed** for Dual Enrollment students. By taking courses, you will be establishing an ISU grade point average.

- 1. Submit Dual Enrollment interest form by Friday, October 21, 2022.
- 2. If the Academic Advisors have questions about course requests, they will send an email to the students **ISU e-mail**, be sure to list the ISU e-mail address on the interest form.
- If you are <u>not</u> currently enrolled in a course at Illinois State or have never taken a course at ISU, you will need to apply to ISU at <u>http://admissions.illinoisstate.edu/apply/</u>
 Your University application must be submitted by Wednesday, October 19, 2022 for Spring 2023. (see attached instructions for how to apply)
- 4. Dual Enrollment student registration will begin Monday, November 7, 2022. The deadline to submit for Dual Enrollment is <u>October 21, 2022</u>. (Once you have been approved, you will receive an e-mail from Kelly Schoon at ISU with instructions on how to register for classes at ISU).
- 5. All students that attend ISU will be required to complete a Financial Agreement before registering. Kelly Schoon will send instructions on how to complete this form once you have been approved for your course request.
- 6. University College Advisor (Kelly Schoon) will also be available by phone (309)438.7925 for registration help during regular office hours (Monday through Friday from 8:30AM to 4:00PM.)
