#### **Dual Enrollment Guide for Parents and Students**

### What are the first steps in taking Dual Enrollment courses at Illinois State?

- Students have approval from their high school guidance office and/or administration
- Once completed, they turn in the Dual Enrollment Interest Form into their High School Counselor who should send it to Kelly Schoon at University College via e-mail at <a href="mailto:kmschoo@ilstu.edu">kmschoo@ilstu.edu</a>
  - Students must list their intended courses, as specifically as possible i.e., section, time class number/name
  - o Parents/Guardians sign the form with the students
- Students must also apply\* to the University at http://admissions.illinoisstate.edu/apply/
  - Students should select <u>"Visiting Non-Degree"</u> and will be prompted to choose "Dual Enrollment High School"
  - The application fee is not required; if the system requests a fee, it will be waived
- \*Note: Failure to submit an application to the University will stop the process

# Where do students park on campus?

- Students will need to have a parking pass or pay for daily parking to park on-campus

- Parking Permit information can be found at <a href="http://parking.illinoisstate.edu/permits/">http://parking.illinoisstate.edu/permits/</a>
- Parking spots in certain lots may be limited during peak class periods

#### What other documentation is needed?

- Immunization history must be sent to Student Health Services (<a href="http://healthservices.illinoisstate.edu/medical-services/immunization-requirements.shtml">http://healthservices.illinoisstate.edu/medical-services/immunization-requirements.shtml</a>)
- AP Test Scores may be required for any coursework requiring college-level prerequisites (For example, Math, Sciences, or Foreign Language to take advance levels at ISU)

#### Are certain courses guaranteed for Dual Enrollment students?

- Course enrollment is not guaranteed and is dependent upon course availability and offerings
- Some Academic Departments restrict certain courses to specific majors and may not be available
- Courses may have prerequisites, please utilize the University Catalog (<a href="http://illinoisstate.edu/catalog/">http://illinoisstate.edu/catalog/</a>)
- An Academic Advisor in University College will review the requested courses and inform the student whether the request is possible

### How does a student enroll in the course itself?\*

- All previous steps must be completed, including review by an Academic Advisor
- Once completed, the student will register using "My.IllinoisState.edu"
  - o Parents are asked not to register on behalf of the student
  - We encourage the student to do so
- \*Note: HS Guidance Counselors, ISU Advisors, and Professors do not enroll students in courses
- \*According to University policy, a student **cannot** attend a course without proper registration

#### How do I access my student's grades?

- The student can access grades on "My.IllinoisState" after grades post
- Parents do not have access to these student accounts; students can log-in and show grades

### How do I know University deadlines like the withdrawal date?

- The University Catalog (http://illinoisstate.edu/catalog/) includes an "Academic Policies" section
  - o Includes course withdrawal policy, repeat policy, and University grading system
  - o These are important policies that should be reviewed
- Academic calendars for each semester can be found at http://registrar.illinoisstate.edu/calendar/.

## What if my student changes his or her mind?

- If a student makes a course request change, this must be approved by the high school first
- If a student chooses not to participate in the program, they should contact his or her Academic Advisor and Guidance Counselor
- If a student decides not to continue once the semester has begun, he or she must withdraw\* from the course(s) as determine by University Policy <a href="http://registrar.illinoisstate.edu/registration/withdrawal/">http://registrar.illinoisstate.edu/registration/withdrawal/</a>

\*Note: HS Guidance Counselors, ISU Advisors, and professors will not withdraw the student

#### Following each step of the process is essential; failure to do so will prevent participation in Dual Enrollment.
