** Explanations:

English: Freshman English, Sophomore Writing, and Oral Communication must be passed. All students must enroll in one survey course: American Literature and Composition, English Literature and Composition, World Literature and Composition, AP English Literature and Composition or AP Language and Composition prior to graduation.

Social Science: United States Studies, Gov't, and the Illinois and Federal Constitution exams must be passed.

Foreign Language/Fine Arts: The two credits must be in one program. Fine Arts include coursework in Art and Music

Additional courses: these include course work in Mathematics, Science, Social Science, Foreign Language, and/or Fine Arts (Art or Music).

Vocational Education: Consumer Education

Wellness/Physical Education: Students are required to enroll in a Wellness/Physical Education course each semester they are attending University High School or secure an appropriate waiver. Health Education (incorporated into Freshman Wellness) must be passed.
