

Mr. Pat Brymer graduated from U High in 1968 and from Illinois State University in 1972 with a theater major and art minor. He has been creating puppets and costume characters for major production companies since 1973. Mr. Brymer was hired after graduation by Sid & Marty Krofft Productions as their lead puppeteer at Six Flags Over Mid-America. From there he went on to work with Raquel Welch in Las Vegas for "Raquel & The World of Sid & Marty Krofft."



After moving to California, Pat was a lead puppeteer for NBC's "Hanna Barbera Happy Hour." In 1982, he formed his own company, pat brymer creations, and received the **1995-1996 Daytime Emmy Award For Outstanding Performer In A Children's Series**. He spent five years as master puppeteer for the Emmy Award winning PBS series "Lamb Chops Play Along," and most recently completed the same assignment for the first season of the new PBS series "The Charlie Horse Music Pizza", both starring Shari Lewis. Pat has also produced costume characters for McDonald's, Kay Bee Toys, Doug Henning, Southwest Airlines, Disney Epcot Center, and Paula Abdul, and was the gopher in the 1980's film "Caddyshack." Other feature films with puppeteering credits include "The Muppet Movie," "Short Circuit, " "My Stepmother Is An Alien," "Indiana Jones & The Last Crusade," and "So I Married An Axe Murderer."
